"Trafficking in Persons" means (a) sex trafficking in which a commercial sex act is induced by force, fraud or coercion, or in which the person induced to perform such act is under 18 years of age; (b) the recruitment, harboring, transportation, provision, or obtaining of a person for labor or services,

through the use of force, fraud, or coercion for the purpose of subjection to involuntary servitude, peonage, debt bondage, or slavery; (c) disallowing the possession or control of an individual's personal identification documents as a means to control them; (d) charging employees recruitment fees.
