We are committed to improving our practices to combat slavery and human trafficking and this statement comprises the slavery and human trafficking statement of Stantec UK Limited. It reflects our ongoing actions on this subject and supports our acc**ston**tthe financial year ending 31 December 2021in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and would also be applicable to any other UK entity in our group that might fall within the scope of the act from time to time.

Stantec UK Limited is a subsidiary company registered in the United Kingdom. Our practices unite engineersplanners, consultantscientists and architects to bring water and infrastructure piects to life. With over 2,000 people working in integrated regional teams across the UK, we plan, design, deliver and manage the development and infrastructure needed to support the creation of sustainable, healthy and prosperous communities. Our ultimparent company is Stantec Inc. which is listed on the New York and Toronto Stock Exchanges. The group has approxionately 2 employees in 400 offices worldwide and engage in engineering, construction, financing and management of the world's largest dimost significant waterinfrastructure, building and natural resources projects

Our supply chains include professional services firms acting acoust bultants (in the delivery of professional services and works), as well as individuate sub-ultants and suppliers of services, goods and equipment to our offices. We also work with transformer companies from time to time.

We are committed to the aim of taking all reasonable steps to try and eradicate modern slavery or human trafficking from our supply chains or any part of our business. Our Code of Business Conduct reflects our commitmento acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls which try to eliminate slavery and human trafficking. This is also suppred by our global **H**man Rights policy.

As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk we have a due diligence process consisting of the following:

- Code of Business Conduct which sets out the group's approach to congbosiness ethically and within the applicable laws.
- Specific Ethics & Compliance department which monitors our global camepl
- Provided updates and linsto awareness training available online to all staff to ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and business.

- Work with our agency staff providers to ensure at least minimum wages are paid to agency staff and no tiens or service charges exist.
